



Oregon Shakespeare Festival 2010 Audience Survey

WolfBrown in cooperation with the Oregon Shakespeare Festival designed and executed the survey. A total of 9,614 administered by mail or online in October 2010 to produce representative results for each of the three main analysis groups (ticket buyers, members and local buyers). The overall response rate was 32% or 3,200 responses. Average mail response rates were 38% and online response rates were 27%. The summary below compares the results of 2007 with those of previous surveys carried out in 2007, 2004, 2000, 1997, 1994 and 1991. Some questions in 2004 were new to the survey and comparisons cannot be drawn from data of previous surveys.
