- Works with ITS development team to ensure total quality management of the site and PCI compliance including consistency, cross-browser compatibility, and ease of use and access security.
- Consults with stakeholders in gathering requirements and design and content specifications
- Works with outside contractors on web development and design projects as needed
- Prepares user documentation for website and web based applications.
- Supports the organization's mission, vision and values including a commitment to diversity and inclusion.
