

Oregon Shakespeare Festival Production History = 1980s

In 1981 the Festival began to introduce intermissions to the productions. We also began to tour more extensively. 1983 marked our final radio broadcast on KSOR. In 1984, after our 1983 Tony award win, the Festival became an Equity house. In 1987, we welcomed our 5 millionth patron. In 1988 we opened OSF Portland with *Heartbreak House*. This expansion made us the largest not-for-profit theatre in the country. The Oregon Shakespearean Festival changes its name to the Oregon Shakespeare Festival. In 1989, OSF Resident Costume Designer Jeannie Davidson completed the canon with the production of *Pericles, Prince of Tyre*. In this decade the Festival produced these World Premieres, including adaptations: 1982 - *The Father*, 1983 – *Dreamhouse*, 1985 - *The Majestic Kid*, 1985 – *An Enemy of the People*.
